

# 2011 GO WILHD Ministries Annual Report

While the results of discipleship are not always readily apparent and the ability to measure spiritual activity in general is hard to quantify, this report will endeavor to measure the width, length, height, and depth of GO WILHD Ministries in 2011 through analyzing various aspects and activities of the ministry.

## **GO WIDE** – *Expanding Influence*

### Number of people/churches served

- Preached 17 sermons in 3 different churches to 140 different people.
- Taught 56 bible training sessions in 6 different locations to 68 different people.
- Led worship/coached worship teams 49 times in 2 different locations to 400 different people.
- Discipled 21 people a total of 107 times.
- Started new church plant, Pueblo Family Fellowship with 6 families.

- Ended year with 197 supporters
- We have 139 prayer partners
- We have 58 financial partners

### **GO DEEP** – *Enduring Impact*

#### Churches Strengthened

- **Alvin and Stephanie Wilkerson** are church planters in **Walsenburg, CO**. They came in response to Calvary Church closing last year. I had worked with **Calvary Church** for three months coaching them in assessing their dire situation. They decided to close, call a church planter, and graciously turn over their assets to them to start a new work. The new church plant is called **New Hope Community Church**.

- **New Heights Baptist Church** – New Heights needed some coaching and training in the area of worship so they asked me to come and help. What was “supposed” to be a one month training situation turned into a one year interim worship leadership opportunity where I was able to not only take them to the next level in their music/worship skills, but also coach the pastor in the hiring process of a new worship leader, and start a new adult small group. Here is what Pastor Dave Grossmann had to say about the experience:
